Born in California in 1946, Guy Dill graduated from the Chouinard Institute of Art, Los Angeles, CA with BFA Honors. Today he is one of the renowned contemporary masters of American abstract sculpture, whose works are collected and exhibited extensively around the world. Both his bronze and marble sculptures, while not figurative, often suggest the lines, curves, and lithe swoop of bodies and movement itself. Dill's sculptures range in size from smaller works for indoors to larger works for outdoors or larger interior spaces. His works are included in many important museum, public and private collections.
